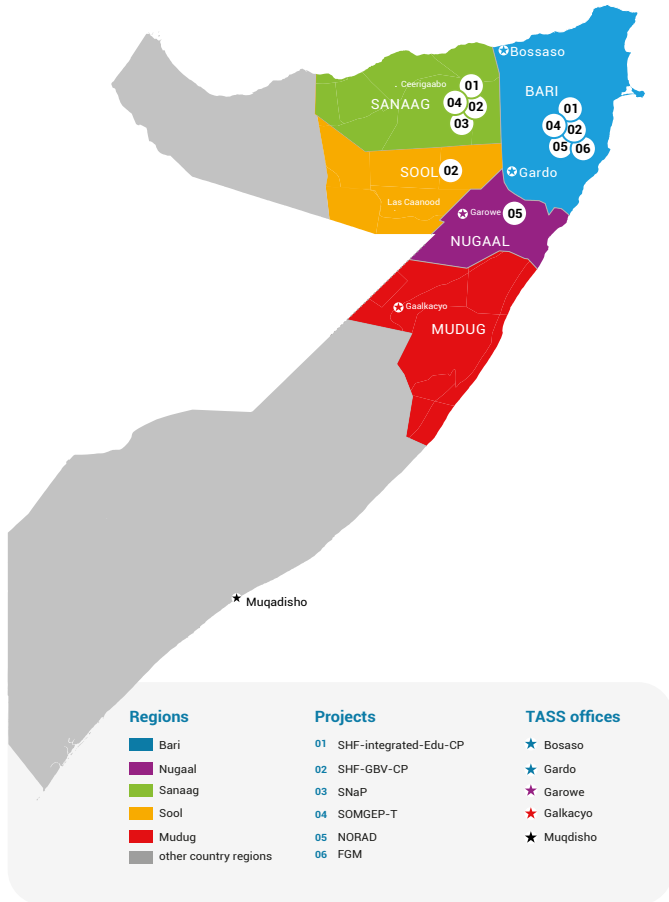

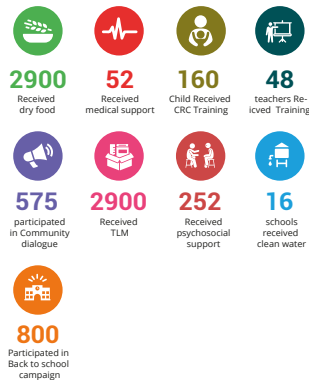
## 01 SHF-Integrated-Edu-CP

The below number represents target recipients



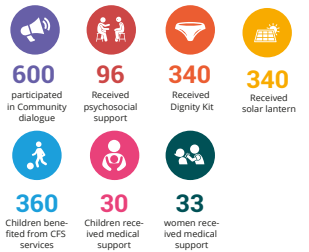
## 02 SHF-GBV-CP

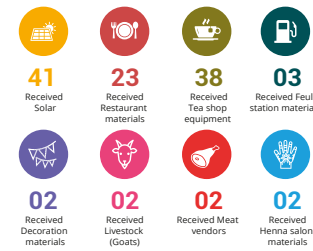
## 03 SNaP Program

The below numbers based on the distribution of equipment and materials to 113 women of VSLA groups



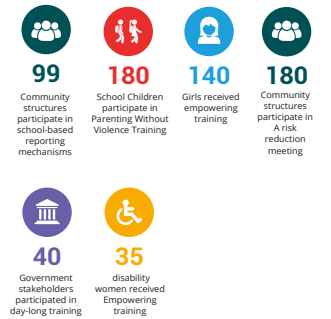
## 05 NORAD Program
